Flipgrid –A social learning platform that students enjoy! The **professor makes videos** and the **students respond via videos** they make.

We use this tool in online classes to allow students to **introduce** themselves to help *create connections*. We also use it for some course **discussion boards**, in lieu of a traditional written discussion. This helps *reinforce oral communication skills*.

Kaltura - We use **video quizzes** embedded in videos to ensure *student participation* and *comprehension*.



Zoom -

Breakout Rooms

allow students to *collaborate* on accounting problems.

Polling

Promotes *student engagement* and provides *real time feedback* to instructors.

Annotate

Allows students (and instructors) to write on the screen for everyone on the session to see.

Student **chat leaders** help moderate live class sessions.

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
