



Fraud Jeopardy

All Zoom participants should keep their score regardless of whether answer orally.

To answer orally:

- Please use the Chat box to participate orally in the game.
- When you think you know the answer and want to “buzz in” enter the letter **A** in the Chat Box.
- I will Unmute your Mic to hear your answer, which must be stated in the form of a question.

For example:

- 1) You will see the Jeopardy board categories and \$ figures on your screen. I will select the first category and dollar figure.

Example question:

This company is the world’s largest anti-fraud organization and provider of anti-fraud training, education. It also offers the exam to become a Certified Fraud Examiner.

- 2) If you want to “buzz in” with your answer, type a **capital A** into the Chat box.
- 3) The 1st person who submits a capital **A** will be unmuted and asked to give his/her answer.
 - If the 1st person is correct, we move on to the next question.
 - If the 1st person is incorrect, the 2nd person who typed the letter **A** into the Chat box is unmuted to share his/her answer.
 - If the first 3 contestants do not provide the correct answer, the moderator will provide the answer and we move on to the next question, which will be chosen by the 4th person who typed an A into the Chat box.
 - To keep track of the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th contestants, you will see the word **CLOSED** in the Chat box after each question is answered.
- 4) Be sure to state your answer in the form of a question:
What is the ACFE?
- 5) You will be asked to post your final score at the end of the game. Some of the questions are simple and some are incredibly challenging, so don’t be shy about sharing your score. You’re not going to win a million dollars even if your score is the highest. ;>) It’s about having some fun and hopefully learning something about fraud you didn’t know before tonight.
